### **INSERT QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

- Q1 What was the last event that impacted the island of St. Croix which required activation and performance by the Public Works disaster debris management contractor?
- A1 **Hurricanes Irma and Maria were the last events.**
- Q2 How many cubic yards of debris was collected in that event?
- A2 **Over 700,000 cubic yards of debris was collected.**
- Q3 Which Contractor held the previous or holds the current contract for services requested in this solicitation?
- A3 **There are currently no contracts in place for the services under this solicitation.**
- Q4 Does the Department of Public Works currently have a disaster debris monitoring firm under contract, and if so, with which company(ies)?
- A4 **Three (3) Contractors have been awarded contracts for Debris Monitoring. GEC, LLC; Tysam Tech, LLC; and Continental Construction and Engineering, Inc.**
- Q5 Please provide the names and titles of the evaluation committee members.
- A5 **To protect the integrity of the process and the committee members, that information will not be shared prior to an award being made.**
- Q6 Please provide the date, time and location when the evaluation committee meeting will be held to evaluate the proposals.
- A6 **The Evaluation Meeting is currently scheduled for Tuesday, August 31, 2021, 2:00 p.m., St. Croix, U.S. Virgin Islands.**
- Q7 Where will the evaluation committee meeting notice be posted?
- A7 **Any notices from the Evaluation Committee will not be posted publicly or otherwise.**

Q8 When will intent to award be made and how will it be communicated to proposers?

A8 Notices of Award and Non-Award will be emailed to proposers once an award has been made.

Q9 Section J, Contents of Proposal 1C. states, “Current Business License or state register for the services being advertised.” Please confirm if the contractor must hold a business license in the island of St. Croix or if US based business license satisfies this requirement.

A9 Only contractors licensed in the U.S. Virgin Islands will be selected for this project.

Q10 Are disposal fees a pass-through cost

A10 Disposal fees are not included.

Q11 Are transportation cost from the island of St. Croix to the island of St. Thomas a pass-through cost?

A11 Debris being shipped from St. Thomas to St. Croix is a mission by FEMA through the Corp of Engineers. The Department of Public Works is not involved in that process.
