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DESCRIPTION OF WORK
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Furnish all labor, materials, and equipment necessary for Installation of Warning Signage in each Direction of Roadways, 42-inch Tubular Markers and or Drums and water filled Barriers at the following locations: Rt 63, Rt 74, Rt 82, and Rt 80. Federal-aid Project No. ER-VI-9999(138).

A schedule of the minimum wages for all labor classifications as determined by the Secretary of Labor pursuant to Section 115 of the Federal Aid Highway Act of 1956 is included in this proposal.

All bidders will be required to execute a sworn statement pursuant to Section 112(c) of Title 23 USC, certifying that he or she has not either directly or indirectly, entered into any agreement, participated in any collusion or otherwise taken any action in restraint of free competitive bidding in connection with such contract. Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, USC 2001d to 2001d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Dept. of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally-assisted programs of the Dept. of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin in consideration for an award.

The Department of Public Works complies with regulations included in 49 CFR Part 26 for Disadvantaged Business Enterprises.
