2. As we'll be interfacing with BIT's facilities fiber will they be available to discuss availability of fiber / bandwidth and use of their FAP's?

The fiber and fiber access points (FAP) are not the assets of BIT. As such, the RFP states that "The vendor is responsible for coordinating with local providers to assess connection requirements and provide the best solution for configuring cameras to operate in an Enterprise environment with the appropriate bandwidth." (Under 3.2.5 Connectivity and 3.0 Scope of Work in the RFP). A local provider could be any local ISP.

Depending on the vendor's design, point to point links and wireless access points can be used. The interface that meet requirements for interfacing the cameras to the network are the battery backup units listed in the RFP under section 3.2.6 Battery Backup. It is the responsibility of the contractor to access the VINGN fiber network.

3. Are any site visits planned with either?
