Purchase and Supply of Hot Mix Asphalt for the Department of Public Works in the St. Croix District

This Agreement made this 17th day of August 2021, in the Territory of the United States Virgin Islands by and between the Government of the Virgin Islands Department of Property and Procurement, on behalf of The Department of Public Works (hereinafter referred to as "Government") and Virgin Islands Paving Inc., whose address is P.O. Box 4720, Kingshill St. Croix U.S.V.I. 00851-4720 (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor"),

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Government is in need of a contractor to provide The Purchase and Supply of Hot Mix Asphalt for the Department of Public Works in the St. Croix District; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor was selected in accordance with V.I.C § 239(a) 8; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor represents that it is willing and capable of providing the services in an expeditious manner and in accordance with the specifications cited in Addendum I and II; it is mutually agreed between the Parties as follows:

Section I. 3. INDEMNIFICATION

Contractor agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Government from and against any and all loss, damage, liability, claims, demands, detriments, cost, charges and expenses (including attorney's fees) and causes of action of whatsoever character which the Government may incur, sustain or be subjected to, arising out of or in any way connected to the services to be performed by Contractor under this Agreement and arising from any cause, except the sole negligence of Government.

4. TERMINATION

The Government shall have the right to terminate this Contract with cause on ten (10) days written notice to the other party specifying the date of termination. The performance of work under this contract may be terminated by the Government in part, whenever the Government shall deem such termination advisable. This partial termination shall be effected by delivering to the Contractor a Notice of Partial Termination specifying the extent to which the terms and/or duties under this Agreement are terminated and the date upon which such termination becomes effective. The Contractor shall be entitled to receive payment for services provided to the date of termination, including payment for the period of the ten (10) day notice.



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5. NON-DISCRIMINATION

7. RIGHT TO WITHHOLD

If work under this Contract is not performed in accordance with the terms, hereof, the Government will have the right to withhold out of any payment due to Contractor, such sums as the Government may deem ample to protect it against loss or to assure payment of claims arising therefrom, and, at its option, the Government may apply such sums in such manner as the Government may deem proper to secure itself or to satisfy such claims. The Government will immediately notify the Contractor in writing in the event that it elects to exercise its right to withhold.

8. FAILURE TO DELIVER

Failure of the Contractor to deliver within the time specified, or within a reasonable time as interpreted by the Government, or failure to make replacement of rejected commodities when so requested, immediately or as directed by the Government, will constitute authority for the Government to purchase in the open market to replace the commodities rejected or not delivered. The Government reserves the right to authorize immediate purchases in the open market against rejections on this contract when necessary. On all such purchases, the Contractor agrees promptly to reimburse the Government for excess costs occasioned by such purchases. Such purchases will be deducted from contract quantities. However,



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should public necessity demand it, the Government reserves the right to use or consume commodities delivered which are substandard in quality, subject to an adjustment in price to be determined by the Government.
