



#### AMENDMENT No. 2 PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT

THIS AMENDMENT made as of the <u>29th</u> day of <u>May</u>, 20<u>25</u> in the Territory of the Virgin Islands, by and between the Government of the Virgin Islands, acting through its **Department of Property and Procurement on behalf of the Department of Human Services**, (hereinafter referred to as "Government") and Geographic Solutions, Inc., whose address is 1001 Omaha Circle Palm Harbor, FL 34683 (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor").

Both parties witness to being duly authorized to execute this agreement and will attest accordingly when and where necessary.

#### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, pursuant to Contract No. P116DHST22 approved by the Commissioner of the Department of Property and Procurement on May 31, 2022, as amended by its Amendment No. 1, approved by Commissioner of the Department of Property and Procurement on August 22, 2023, and as renewed by Renewal Option No. 1 approved by the Commissioner of the Department of Property and Procurement on May 11, 2023, and as renewed by Renewal Option No. 2 approved by the Commissioner of the Department of Property and Procurement on May 11, 2023, and as renewed by Renewal Option No. 2 approved by the Commissioner of the Department of Property and Procurement on May 20, 2024, (which constitute and are hereinafter referred to as the "Contract"), the Government contracted with Contractor to provide a case management and reporting system to interface with the Virgin Islands Department of Labor VI Electronic Workforce System, to assist the Department of Human Services' Vocational Rehabilitation program with operations to include federal reporting; and

WHEREAS, the Contract expires pursuant to its terms on May 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Contract, to extend its term and add additional renewal options; and

WHEREAS, the amendment of the Contract pursuant to this Amendment of Professional Services Contract shall not result in any change to the scope of work provided for under the Contract.

**NOW THEREFORE**, for mutual and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. The Contract, is hereby amended and its term extended by deleting all existing language contained in Paragraph 2 and replacing it with language as follows:

"The Term of this Contract shall be from May 31, 2022, to May 31, 2026. Upon the execution of this Contract by the Governor of the U.S. Virgin Islands, this Contract shall be effective for the Term set out herein. The Government in its sole discretion will have the option to renew this Contract for the period of June 1, 2026, through May 31, 2027, upon the same terms by providing the Contractor with sixty (60) days written notice of the Government's election to renew the Contract."

 Paragraph No. 3 – Compensation is hereby amended to change the maximum compensation from Three Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Four and 00/100 Dollars (\$354,674.00) to One Million Seventy-Six Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-Six and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,076,936.00) by deleting all of the existing language contained therein and replacing it with new language as follows:

"The Government, in consideration of the satisfactory performance of the services described in Addendum I (Scope of Services) agrees to pay Contractor the sum not to exceed One Million Seventy-Six Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-Six and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,076,936.00) in accordance with the provisions set forth in Addendum II (Compensation) attached hereto and made a part of this Contract."

- 3. Addendum II, Compensation of the Contract is amended by deleting Three Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Four and 00/100 Dollars (\$354,674.00) from the introductory paragraph and inserting One Million Seventy-Six Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-Six and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,076,936.00) in its place.
- 4. Addendum II of the Contract is amended by deleting all of the text and chart on Page 17 and replacing it with the information below:

## **CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES**

**THIS AGREEMENT** is made this <u>31st</u> day of <u>May</u>, 2022, in the Territory of the Virgin Islands, by and between the Government of the Virgin Islands, Department of Property and Procurement, on behalf of the Department of Human Services (hereinafter referred to as "Government") and **Geographic Solutions, Inc.**, (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor").

### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Government is in need of the services of a Contractor to provide a case management and reporting system to interface with the Virgin Islands Department of Labor ("VIDOL") VI Electronic Workforce System (VIeWS), to assist the Department of Human Services ("DHS") Vocational Rehabilitation program with operations to include federal reporting which duties and responsibilities are more particularly described in Addendum I (Scope of Services) attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this project is to install and integrate the *Vocational Rehabilitation Case Management and Reporting module* into VIeWS operated by the Department of Labor. The module will be accessible through a portal as a 'thin site' with information unique for the DHS clients but share the VIeWS database.

WHEREAS, the Contractor was selected in accordance with 31 V.I.C. § 239(a) (8); and

WHEREAS, the Contractor represents that it is willing and capable of providing such services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, and intending to be legally bound by this written instrument, the parties hereto do covenant and agree as follows:

#### **1. SERVICES**

The Contractor will provide the services described in Addendum I (Scope of Services) attached hereto and made a part of this contract.

### 2. TERM AND EFFECTIVE DATE

This Contract shall be effective upon the date of execution of this Contract by the Commissioner of the Department of Property and Procurement and shall terminate one (1) year thereafter. The Government in its sole discretion, shall have the option to renew this Contract for a period of two (2) additional one-year periods subject to the same terms noted herein at the rates provided for in Addendum II, by providing the Contractor with sixty (60) days written notice of the Government's election to renew.

## **3. COMPENSATION**

The Government, in consideration of the satisfactory performance of the services described in Addendum I (Scope of Services), agrees to pay Contractor a sum not to exceed Three Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Four and 00/100 Dollars (\$354,674.00) in accordance with the provisions set forth in Addendum II (Compensation) attached hereto and made a part of this contract.

### 4. TRAVEL EXPENSES

Inclusive of the compensation for services as specified in Paragraph 3 (Compensation) above, the Government agrees to pay documented transportation, subsistence, lodging and other travel expenses, while in travel status, for trips which have been authorized in writing, in advance, by the Government. These costs shall be advanced or reimbursed on the same basis as is applicable to non-contract employees of the Government, or as agreed to by an addendum to this Contract, however, said costs and expenses shall not exceed N/A (\$ N/A).

### 5. RECORDS

The Contractor when applicable, will present documented precise records of time and/or money expended under this Contract.

# 6. PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS

The Contractor agrees to maintain the professional standards applicable to its profession and to consultants doing business in the United States Virgin Islands.

# 7. DOCUMENTS, PRINTOUTS, ETC.

Contractor's Initials:





All documents, books, records, instructional materials, programs, printouts, and memoranda of every description derived therefrom, provided by the Government, shall remain the property of the Government and shall be returned to it at the termination of this Contract. The above-described materials shall not be used by Contractor or by any other person or entity except upon the written permission of the Government.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Government understands that it is receiving a non-exclusive, non-transferable, limited right to use the Software that is the subject of this Contract as outlined in Addendum III ("License Agreement").

## **8. LIABILITY OF OTHERS**

Nothing in this Contract shall be construed to impose any liability upon the Government to persons, firms, associations, or corporations engaged by Contractor as servants, agents, or independent contractors, or in any other capacity whatsoever, or make Government liable to any such persons, firms, associations, or corporations for the acts, omissions, liabilities, obligations and taxes of Contractor of whatsoever nature, including but not limited to unemployment insurance, gross receipt, excise, and social security taxes for Contractor, its servants, agents or independent contractors.

#### 9. ASSIGNMENT

The Contractor shall not subcontract or assign any part of the services under this Contract without the prior written consent of the Government.

#### **10. INDEMNIFICATION**

Contractor agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Government from and against any and all loss, damage, liability, claims, demands, detriments, costs, charges and expenses (including attorney's fees) and causes of action of whatsoever character which Government may incur, sustain or be subjected to, arising out of or in any way connected to the services to be performed by Contractor under this Contract and arising from any cause, except the sole negligence of Government.

### **11. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR**

The Contractor shall perform this Contract as an independent contractor, and nothing herein contained shall be construed to be inconsistent with this relationship or status.

## **12. GOVERNING LAW**

This Contract shall be governed by the laws of the United States Virgin Islands and jurisdiction shall remain in the United States Virgin Islands.

## **13. WAIVERS AND AMENDMENTS**

No waiver, modification or amendment of any term, condition, or provision of this Contract shall be valid or of any force or effect unless made in writing, signed by the parties hereto or their duly authorized representatives, and specifying with particularity the nature and extent of such waiver, modification, or amendment. Any such waiver, modification or amendment in any instance or instances shall in no event be construed to be a general waiver, modification, or amendment of any of the terms, conditions, or provisions of this Contract, but the same shall be strictly limited and restricted to the extent and occasion specified in such signed writing or writings.

## **14. ENTIRE AGREEMENT**

Including Addenda identified in Section 23 herein, this agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties relating to the subject matter addressed in this Agreement. This agreement supersedes all prior communications, contracts, or agreements between the parties with respect to the subject matter addressed in this agreement, whether written or oral.

### **15. RIGHT TO WITHHOLD**

If work under this Contract is not performed in accordance with the terms hereof, Government will have the right to withhold out of any payment due to Contractor, such sums as Government may deem ample to protect it against loss or to assure payment of claims arising therefrom, and, at its option, Government may apply such sums in such manner as Government may deem proper to secure itself or to satisfy such claims. Government will immediately notify the Contractor in writing in the event that it elects to exercise its right to withhold.

No such withholding or application shall be made by Government if and while Contractor gives satisfactory assurance to Government that such claims will be paid by Contractor or its insurance carrier, if applicable in the event that such contest is not successful.

## **16. CONDITION PRECEDENT**

This Contract shall be subject to the availability and appropriation of funds and to the approval of the Commissioner of the Department of Property and Procurement.

### **17. TERMINATION**

Either party will have the right to terminate this Contract with or without cause on sixty (60) days written notice to the other party specifying the date of termination.

### **18. PARTIAL TERMINATION**

The performance of work under this Contract may be terminated by the Government, in part, whenever the Government shall deem such termination advisable by sixty (60) days written notice to the Contractor. This partial termination shall be effected by delivering to the Contractor a Notice of Partial Termination specifying the extent to which the term and/or duties under this Contract are terminated and the date upon which such termination becomes effective. The Contractor shall be entitled to receive payment for services provided to the date of termination, including payment for the period of the sixty (60) day notice.

### **19. NON-DISCRIMINATION**

No person shall be excluded from participating in, be denied the proceeds of or be subject to discrimination in the performance of this Contract on account of race, creed, color, sex, religion, disability, or national origin.

### **20. CONFLICT OF INTEREST**

(a) Contractor covenants that it has no interest and will not acquire any interest direct or indirect, which would conflict in any manner or degree with the performance of services required to be performed under this Contract.

- not a territorial officer or employee (i.e., the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, member of the Legislature, or any other elected territorial official; or an officer or employee of the legislative, executive, or judicial branch of the Government or any agency, board, commission or independent instrumentality of the Government, whether compensated on a salary, fee or contractual basis); or
- (2) a territorial officer or employee and, as such, has:
  - (i) familiarized itself with the provisions of Title 3, Chapter 37 of the Virgin Islands Code, pertaining to conflicts of interest, including the penalties provision set forth in section 1108 thereof;
  - (ii) not made, negotiated, or influenced this Contract, in its official capacity; and
  - (iii) no financial interest in the Contract as that term is defined in section 1101(1) of said Code chapter.

### 21. NOTICE

Any notice required to be given by the Terms of this Contract shall be deemed to have been given when the same is sent by certified mail, postage prepaid or personally delivered, addressed to the parties as follows:

## **22. LICENSURE**

The Contractor covenants that it has:

- (b) familiarized itself with the applicable provisions of Title 27 of the Virgin Islands Code pertaining to professions and occupations.

## **23. OTHER PROVISIONS**

Addenda I, II, and III, which includes Exhibits A, B, C, and D attached hereto are a part of this Contract and are incorporated herein by reference.

### 24. DEBARMENT CERTIFICATION

By execution of this contract, the contractor certifies that it is eligible to receive contract awards using federally appropriated funds and that it has not been suspended or debarred from entering into contracts with any federal agency. The Contractor shall include this provision in each of its subcontracts hereunder and shall furnish its subcontractors with the current "LIST OF PARTIES EXCLUDED FROM FEDERAL PROCUREMENT OR NON-PROCUREMENT". In the event the Contractor or any subcontractor misrepresents its eligibility to receive contract awards using federal funds, the Contractor or subcontractor agrees that it shall not be entitled to payment for any work performed under this contract or any subcontract and that the Contractor or subcontractor shall promptly reimburse the Government of the Virgin Islands for any progress payments heretofore made.

### 25. FALSE CLAIMS

Contractor warrants that it shall not, with respect to this Contract, make or present any claim upon or against the Government of the Virgin Islands, or any officer department, board, commission, or

other agency thereof, knowing such claims to be false, fictitious, or fraudulent. Contractor acknowledges that making such a false, fictitious, or fraudulent claim is an offence under Virgin Islands law.

# **26. NOTICE OF FEDERAL FUNDING**

Contractor acknowledges that this Contract is funded, in whole or in part, by federal funds. Contractor warrants that it shall not, with respect to this Contract, make or present any claim knowing such claim to be false, fictitious, or fraudulent. Contractor acknowledges that making such a false, fictitious, or fraudulent claim is a federal offence.

### **27. INSURANCE**

Contractor shall maintain the following insurance coverages during the term of this Contract

- (a) COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY: Commercial general liability insurance, in a form acceptable to the Government, on a "per occurrence" basis with a minimum limit of not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for any one person per occurrence for death or personal injury and one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for any one occurrence for property damage. Insurance policy(ies) shall name the Government of the Virgin Islands as the certificate holder and additional insured via an endorsement.
- (b) PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY: Professional liability insurance, in a form acceptable to the Government, which covers the services being performed under this Contract, with policy limits of not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per claim. The Government shall be listed thereon as a certificate holder.
- (c) WORKERS' COMPENSATION: Contractor shall supply current coverage under the Government Insurance Fund or other form of coverage.
